

Registration

- 1. Registration for the ladder will close on April 22, 2023 at 11:59PM.
- 2. Registration for the ladder will be open to all adult members of the Bayview Village Tennis Club.
- 3. All participants will be required to create a tennisrungs.com profile. Tennisrungs is the website/app that will host the ladder.
- 4. The ladder will run from May 1, 2023 to September 4, 2023.

Ranking

- 5. The order of the initial rankings will be determined by the following factors:
 - a. Previous year tournament finish
 - b. Previous year intercounty team members

As players play matches, their ranking will be adjusted up and down based on merit.

6. Players who are inactive for **15 days** without notifying the convenor for the reason and duration, will move down **one** rank spot each day. Players who are inactive for **25 days** will be removed from the ladder.

Challenges

- 7. Players can challenge up to **5** spots ahead within their division. Only players ranked between **#1 #3** can challenge players below them in the ladder. Players ranked **#1 #3** can challenge up to **5** spots below.
- 8. During the course of the season players will be required to play a minimum of **12** matches. A player must issue 6 challenges and accept 6 challenges.
- 9. Players are required to respond to challenge requests (accept or decline) as soon as practicable, but must be within **3 days.** If a player does not accept or decline a challenge within 3 days, the player will take a forfeit for the challenge.

- 10. After a challenge is accepted, the match must be played within 7 days.
- 11. If a lower ranked player beats a higher ranked player, the lower ranked player swaps positions with the higher ranked player. If the higher ranked player beats a lower ranked player both player's ranks remain the same.
- 12. Players can not play back to back matches against each other.
- 13. Players may issue **up to 3** challenges at one time.
- 14. Players will be limited to **one** active ladder challenge at a time.

Match Play

- 15. Both players must bring a new can of approved tennis balls:
 - a. Wilson US Open Extra Duty
 - b. Dunlop ATP Championship
 - c. PENN Pro Penn Regular or Extra Duty
- 16. The challenger will open his/her new can. The winner will take the unopened can and the loser will keep the used can.
- 17. The winner is responsible for submitting the match results to the tennisrungs platform as soon as practicable but no longer than **24 hours**.
- 18. The match should be a **Pro-8** format. A match is 1 set up to 8 games. If the score is 7 7, a 7 Point tie-breaker should determine the winner.
- 19. If a match is interrupted due to court booking expiry, weather, or unforeseen circumstances, a match will not count as completed unless a player has reached 6 games won in the set.
- 20. If a player retires due to injury, the match will be considered forfeited, and the opponent will be awarded the win.
- 21. A match is considered a forfeit if there is a cancellation within **6** hours of the match. You must notify the convenor by email if this happens.
- 22. Players must follow the rules of the BVTC online court booking system.

Penalties

- 23. If the challenger fails to provide a **new** can of approved balls, he/she will default the win to their opponent.
- 24. A player who is **15 minutes** late to their match will default their match to their opponent.
- 25. If a player breaks the Bayview Village Tennis Code of Conduct they may be subject to removal from the ladder by the BVTC Tournament Director- Sid Gojer.
- 26. If the convener receives three complaints from three different participants about a player who:
 - a. Fails to respond to challenges
 - b. Unwilling to play
 - c. Poor sportsmanship/cheating

The matter will be brought to the BVTC Tournament Director - Sid Gojer and will be investigated.

27. All complaints regarding breaches of the Bayview Village Tennis Club *Rules and Regulators* and *Code of Conduct* will be investigated by the BVTC Tournament Director-Sid Gojer.
